### About the changes

The changes include new and updated questions in line with current practice and legislation, simplified scoring and updated revision materials.

Candidates will still have **45 minutes** to complete the test. Special assistance such as sign language and translators etc. will be available as before.

### What these changes mean for your workforce

Anyone taking the test **on or after 26 June 2019** will need to ensure that they have purchased the updated **2019 revision materials**, which reflect the changes to the test. If their test is **before the 26 June 2019**, they will need the **2018 versions**.
